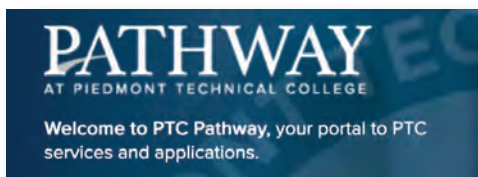

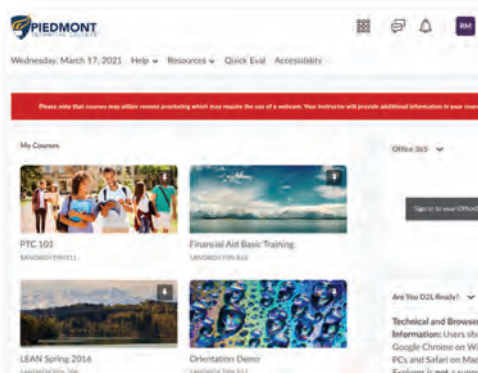
PTC Pathway

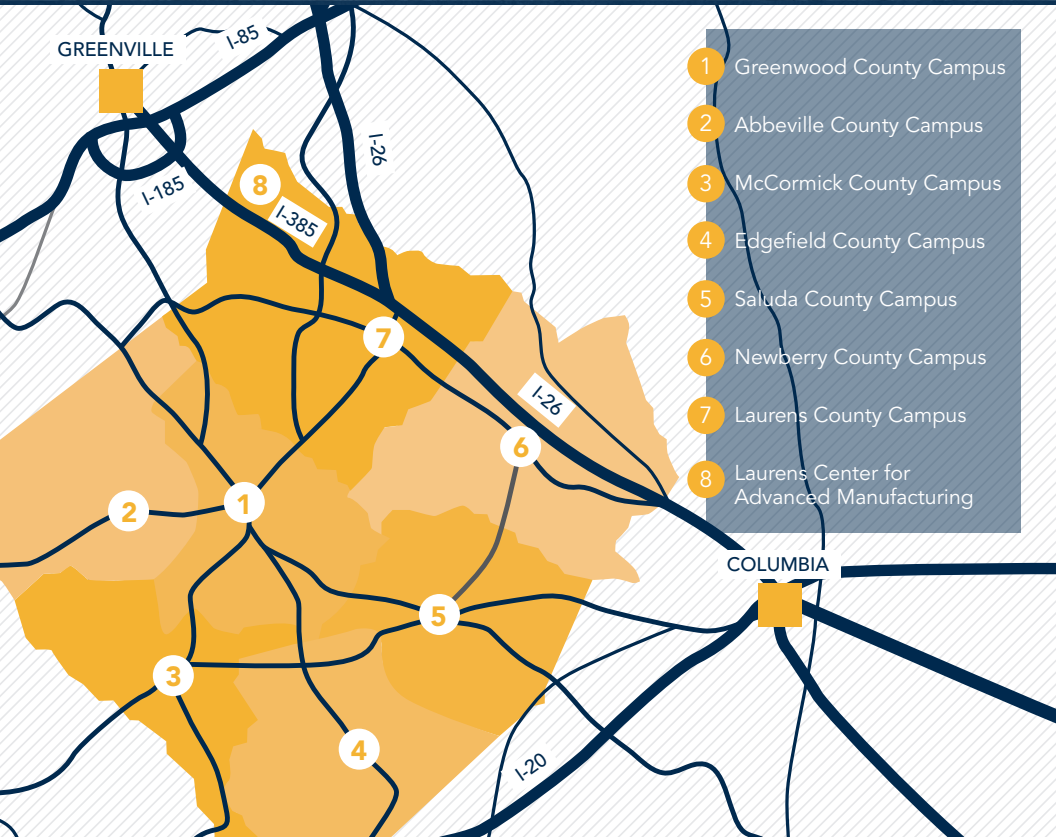
